**Temporary Year 6 Closure –Remote Learning until Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November  
Coronavirus Outbreak Management Plan**

Dear Parents,

Last weekend, following rising cases and the ongoing 'Coronavirus outbreak within our school', we made the difficult decision to temporarily move to Remote Learning for our Year 6 pupils for three days. **Unfortunately, we have had further positive cases confirmed within Year 6. Therefore, to keep cases under control in the rest of the school we will be continuing with remote learning for the next two days.** It remains open as usual to the rest of the school.

To reassure you, the number of new confirmed cases does seem to be slowing so we **fully anticipate re-opening for Year 6 on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November.** Their attendance arrangements will still be restricted and we will keep them within a restricted group for one further week. Their times will be 8:40am to 3:10pm.

We have also reacted quickly and teachers have had some training on **Google Classrooms** which they will **use from tomorrow.** There will be a live check-in at **9am** with Mrs Picillo and Mrs Massingham. Their work for the day will be set there. All pupils just need to log into google classroom on a laptop, table or phone using their email address which follows the format: initialsurname@ssjacademy.co.uk e.g. [jbrown@ssjacademy.co.uk](mailto:jbrown@ssjacademy.co.uk). Their password will be Stanground01 and this much be changed on the first login for online security. They need to use a code to enter the Year 6 classroom which is **tg53mxu** to access the meeting in the stream. Work can be **turned in** once complete and there will be no need for printing. This is a much simpler system and gives pupils the opportunities to see and speak to their teachers every day.

The school will still remain open for Year 6 pupils of **Key Worker parents** this week who cannot work from home and pupils identified by the school as vulnerable. Please contact us if you believe your child fulfils this criterion.

**We will offer free packed lunches to collect from school for any Year 6 pupil eligible for Free School Meals.** These will be available to collect from 12 midday each day from the office and please contact us if you think you are eligible to book.

**If you have not already done so, please book a PCR test for your child.** When ordering a PCR test it is important to check the box (online) or tell 119 'I've been told to get a test by my health protection team' **and not** 'I've been told to get a test by my school or nursery'.
